Section 2001(i)(2) of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 requires LEAs to seek public comment on their spending plan for ARP ESSER funds and to take public input into account when developing their spending plans. Regulations promulgated by the U.S. Department of Education, pursuant to its authority under this Act, provide, in developing their ARP ESSER spending plans for submission to the State Educational Authority (SEA), LEAs must “engage in meaningful consultation – (A) with stakeholders, including: Students; families; . . . and (B) To the extent present in or served by the LEA: . . . civil rights organizations (including disability rights organizations); and stakeholders representing the interest of children with disabilities, English learners, . . . and other underserved students.
